A meeting of the legal voters, town of Warren, N.H., residing on South Main St., from the store of John H. Nicol South to residence of Clarence W. Kemp, both inclusive, will be held at the Warren, N.H. town hall Wed. evening March 14, 1945 at 7.30 PM for the following purposes:

1. To see if they will vote to establish a village district for the purpose of supplying water for either domestic or fire purposes or both.
2. If so established give to it a name.
3. To choose necessary officers therefor to hold office until the first annual meeting.
4. To see if the district will vote by a two thirds majority of those present and voting to acquire or take over and operate, effective May 1st 1945 what is now known as the R.E. Keysar water system.  
(Note) Another vote similar to above will be necessary at the annual meeting in March this year to ratify such acquirement of said plant and property at price set in writing by the R.E. Keysar water system.
5. To transact any other business proper to come before this meeting.
