Breezy Point Bridge Approach Repair

SCOPE OF WORK: BREEZY POINT BRIDGE APPROACH REPAIR

The Town of Warren seeks a contractor to work under the supervision of the Town's Road Agent to complete a mitigation project at Breezy Point Road to restore the bridge approach to a status that ensures its designed function and capacity within the existing footprint.

All aggregate materials and concrete blocks will be picked up at the Warren Transfer Station or delivered by (or as arranged) by Town of Warren. The Contractor will be permitted to utilize the parking area near the swimming hole for staging, if needed.

Contractor is responsible for all cleanup when completed.

Contractor will follow N.H. DOT Best Management procedures.

The mitigation repairs will start no sooner than May 23, 2022 and be completed no later than January 1, 2023.

Additional Information: During the event of October 29 - November 1, 2017 excessive high velocity flow in Baker River flooded over the Breezy Point Bridge by 4 ft, eroded natural stone protection and undermined right abutment. The Town of Warren proposes to replace present stone and gravel armoring at the abutment with tight fitting concrete blocks. This will require 68 blocks 6 ft x 3 ft x 1.5 ft on the upstream face and 30 blocks 3 ft x 3 ft x 1.5 ft on the downstream face.

Scope Notes:

1) The Town of Warren estimates that the project will require the removal of approximately 267 CY of 1-1/2-inch and 5/8-inch minus gravel from the bridge approach.



2) The Town of Warren estimates that the project will require: 28 CY of 1-1/2-inch gravel, 42 CY of 5-inch minus gravel, 68 each of 6-FT x 3-FT x 1.5-FT waste concrete blocks and 15 each 3-FT x 3-FT x 1.5-FT waste concrete blocks.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS: The Contractor agrees that it will carry any and all insurance which will protect it, the Town of Warren and their officials, agents, volunteers and employees from any and all claims and demands, costs, damages, loss of service or consortium, expenses, compensation, and attorneys' fees including but not limited to any and all claims for personal injury and/or death, workers' compensation injuries, and property damages which may, in any way, arise from or out of the operations of the Contractor whether such operations be performed by the Contractor itself, anyone directly or indirectly employed by it or any other persons or company retained in any way to carry on all or portion of the operations, activities or work required by or related to the Contract. The Contractor further agrees that the Town of Warren and its officials, agents, volunteers and employees shall be named as an additional insured in any and all such liability insurance policies required by the Town of Warren. The Town of Warren reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
