

TOWN OF WARREN
Community Development Block Grant Public Hearings

The Warren Board of Selectmen will hold 3 consecutive Public Hearings on Wednesday, May 31, 2023 at 5:00pm at 8 Water Street, Warren, NH. Community Development Block Grant funds are available to municipalities through the NH Community Development Finance Authority. Up to \$500,000 annually is available for economic development projects, up to \$500,000 for public facility projects, up to \$500,000 for housing projects, up to \$350,000 for emergency activities, and up to \$25,000 is available per planning study grant. All CDBG projects must primarily benefit low and moderate income persons. The purpose of these hearings:

1. A proposed application to the Community Development Finance Authority for up to \$500,000 in Community Development Block Grant funds. The town will retain up to \$25,000 for administrative/labor compliance expenses and the remainder will be subgranted to Glenclyff Improvement Company which provides drinking water to 17 customers on High Street, NH Route 25 and Station Road in the Glenclyff Village area of Warren, NH. The funds will be used toward water system improvements including source, storage and distribution improvements. The majority of the residents served by the system are of low and moderate income.
2. The Residential Antidisplacement and Relocation Assistance Plan for the proposed Glenclyff Improvement Company Water Improvements Project.
3. The Housing and Community Development Plan.
